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Resolution Encouraging Governor Kathy Hochul and the New York State Legislature to Increase the Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) Budget Allocation for County Jails

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 9 WHEREAS, local correctional facilities are obligated by Mental Hygiene Law section
 10 19.18-c to provide medication-assisted-treatment (MAT) services to incarcerated
 11 individuals who have been diagnosed with a substance use disorder; and

- WHEREAS, the provision of MAT must also be accompanied by tangential therapeutic
 services ranging from counseling, to peer support, to discharge planning; and
- WHEREAS, in many circumstances obtaining the specific medications necessary to be
 compliant with the law, particularly methadone, is a costly and time intensive endeavor;
 and
- WHEREAS, the annual appropriation provided in the State's Aid to Localities Budget
 has remained static at the insufficient amount of 8.865 million, to support the efforts of
 56 county jails.

 Counties (NYSAC) will join in the efforts of the New York State Sheriffs' Association to
 seek increased funding for this mandated and important public service; and

 appropriation of \$20 million; and
