2023 NYSAC Fall Seminar 1 Standing Committee on Public Health and Mental Health 2 Resolution #2 3 4 Resolution in Support of Making Chickenpox a Reportable Vaccine-5 6 **Preventable Disease** 7 8 **WHEREAS**, chickenpox (varicella) is a highly contagious viral infection that poses significant health risks, particularly to vulnerable populations, such as infants, pregnant 9 women, immunocompromised individuals, and adults at higher risk for complications; 10 and 11 12 WHEREAS, vaccination is a safe and effective method for preventing chickenpox and 13 its associated complications; and 14 15 WHEREAS, robust public health surveillance is essential for monitoring disease 16 incidence, identifying outbreaks, and evaluating the effectiveness of vaccination efforts. 17 18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, New York State shall amend the list of 19 reportable diseases to include chickenpox (varicella) as a reportable vaccine-preventable 20 disease; and 21 22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, healthcare providers, laboratories, and other entities 23 involved in diagnosing and treating cases of chickenpox shall be required to report all 24 confirmed and suspected cases to New York State Department of Health promptly upon 25 26 diagnosis; and 27 28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the reporting requirements shall include relevant data necessary for public health surveillance and monitoring; and 29 30 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the New York State Department of Health 31 (NYSDOH) shall establish clear guidelines and procedures for reporting chickenpox 32 cases, including the use of standardized case definitions and reporting formats; and 33 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that NYSDOH shall ensure the confidentiality and 35 privacy of individuals whose information is reported in accordance with all applicable 36 laws and regulations; and 37 38 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that NYSDOH shall provide training and resources to 39 healthcare providers, laboratories, and other relevant stakeholders to facilitate 40 compliance with the reporting requirements; and 41 42 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that New York State Department of Health shall 43 notify all authorized vaccine providers, including healthcare providers, healthcare 44 facilities, and community organizations, of new requirements, the importance of 45

recording adult vaccinations, and the benefits of participating in the NYSIIS and CIR; 1 2 and 3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that NYSDOH shall regularly analyze and publish 4 reports on chickenpox incidence and vaccination coverage based on the data collected 5 6 from the reporting system to inform the public and healthcare stakeholders about 7 disease trends and vaccination efforts; and 8 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that copies of this resolution be sent to the counties 9 of New York encouraging member counties to enact similar resolutions; and 10 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that New York State Association of Counties shall 12 forward copies of this resolution to Governor Kathy Hochul, the New York State 13 Legislature, NYSDOH Acting Commissioner James McDonald, and all others deemed 14 necessary and proper. 15 16
